

Mobile Mechanical HFCWO Vest Therapy



The AffloVest can be an effective airway clearance therapy for improving bronchial drainage by enhancing mobilization of secretions. It can be used for the treatment of respiratory diseases such as bronchiectasis, cystic fibrosis, and neuromuscular diseases.

The AffloVest is the first fully mobile battery operated HFCWO vest scientifically engineered to closely mimic manual Chest PT

Daily productive (mucus) cough for at least 6 continuous months

Well-documented failure of other treatment to adequately mobilize retained secretions/airway clearance

AND



Diagnosis confirmed via a CT scan

^{*} AffloVest requires a doctor's prescription for treatment by High Frequency Chest Wall Oscillation (HFCWO). The AffloVest has received the FDAs 510k clearance for U.S. market availability, and is approved for Medicare, Medicaid, and private health insurance reimbursement under the Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System(HCPCS) code E0483 – High Frequency Chest Wall Oscillation. The AffloVest is also available through the U.S Department of Veterans Affairs/Tricare. Patients must qualify to meet insurance eligibility requirements.

What is Bronchiectasis?

Bronchiectasis is a chronic condition that occurs when the walls of the airways (bronchi) thicken as a result of chronic inflammation and/or chest infections and result in mucus accumulation.

Bronchiectasis can be tricky because it often presents like COPD, but won't respond to COPD therapy. In fact, studies show it's much more prevalent than what's being diagnosed.


